

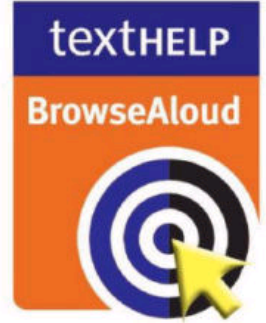
Speech-enabling our websites with Browsealoud

Browsealoud is an investment we have made to speech-enable each of the group's websites. We have also added another feature, powered by google which translates the websites into other languages.

Browsealoud is a unique text-to-speech solution from Texthelp that reads website content aloud and highlights each word as it is spoken. This combination greatly improves comprehension for those with literacy difficulties, such as dyslexia, those with mild visual impairments or those for whom English is a second language.

We are keen to improve the accessibility of our websites for those who find reading text online difficult. Browsealoud and the google translation are simple features to implement. With the google translation feature, all users have to do is select the language of choice from the drop-down menu and watch the page translate. With Browsealoud all our website visitors have to do is download the service and hover their mouse over the text to hear it read aloud simple.
